Policy

Objectives and Strategies

- To ensure that no work starts without confirmation that safety systems are in place and that if any person becomes endangered, operations are to be suspended.

- To provide ongoing education and training to all of our employees.
- To promote a proactive approach to occupational health, safety and environment - and encourage all personnel to participate actively in the development of related programs.
- To provide appropriate levels of health care and rehabilitation for all personnel.
- To ensure that all employees, contractors and third parties are provided with occupational health, safety and environmental information, and clearly understand and adhere to this policy and where necessary to provide assistance to them to comply with the requirements of this policy.
